### **Guest Policy >>>**

Each foursome containing a maximum of 3 guests must contain at least one member. A person residing in Woodbury County or a county contiguous thereto may not be a guest more than three times in any calendar year, whether or not they are the guest of the same member.

### **Definition of a Guest >>>**

A person who holds no membership classification at the Club.

### **Social Members >>>**

A Social member of the Club may play three times per calendar year by paying a discounted green fee. All other fees apply.

### **Lockers >>>**

Men's and Ladies lockers are available through the Golf Shop.

### **Dress Code >>>**

Suitable and appropriate golf attire including spikeless footwear must be worn at all times on the golf course and practice area.

For Men: No tank tops, printed tee shirts, cut-offs, bathing suits or athletic shorts. For Women: No halter tops, bathing suits or athletic shorts. The Golf Shop staff is authorized to determine the definition of suitable attire.

### **Pace of Play >>>**

Players are expected to maintain their position on the course and allow faster groups to play through whenever there is one clear hole ahead. Under normal conditions, all players should complete 18 holes in 4 hours or less. Players or groups that cause delays should consider reducing their number of players, incorporating procedures to increase their speed or play at a time when the course is less crowded.

## **2012 Tournament/Handicap Rules and Regulations**

*In order to enhance participation, as well as protect the integrity of Club events, the following shall apply:*

*The Golf Shop Staff will be responsible for entering ALL scores in the computer on a daily basis during the season. Members will be responsible for returning their scorecards (9 or 18 hole) to the Golf Shop for posting. Equitable Stroke Control shall be utilized in all posting of scores.*

*~ Continuous failure to report scores will be addressed by the Committee*

*~ Tournament handicaps for members and/or their guests will be reviewed and/or adjusted based on prior tournament scoring.*

*~ All event scores will be kept on file for future review.*

*~ All members and their guests must have a valid handicap to participate in Club events.*

*~ In accordance with USGA rules, any club or ball that is deemed non-conforming will not be allowed in any golf event at Sioux City Country Club or any casual round that is to be posted for handicap purposes.*

*~ Local rules are posted in the Golf Shop.*
